The Protege Guide to Becoming a Transformational Christ Follower and Transformational Leader

It's the invitation for us to *sit at his feet daily* (cf. *Luke 10:39*), and become the right kind of person in character and essence.

This quest is rooted in personally engaging in a transformational relationship with Christ, fully devoting ourselves to the person and mission of Christ.

As a protege establishes this relationship, they will become difference makers - people who transform the world one human heart at a time. People who speak un-compromised truth with a contagious, compelling, and undeniable love.
