Follow the steps in this guide to complete the admission process.



Partner Site Admission Checklist

Applying to SEU is simple! After completing our online application, just be sure to submit each of the items listed below. We can't consider you for admission until **all** documents have been received, so don't wait.

Note: Before beginning SEU's application, check with your site director to see if you need to fill out a separate application for your church's internship program. If so, complete that application first.

- ✓ SEU Application (partners.seu.edu)
- ✓ High School Transcripts
(Not required if transferring 60+ credits)
- ✓ College Transcripts
(Only required if transferring credits, including dual enrollment and advanced placement credits)

APPLYING TO YOUR SITE

Tip!

When applying to SEU, go to partners.seu.edu and be sure to select the correct site name on the drop down. Sites are listed by church and organization name (not the name of your site's internship program).



Financial Aid

SEU makes paying for college easy and affordable. Be sure to make your payment arrangements before the start of each semester (that way you can start your classes on time). You can choose to set up a payment plan, offset your tuition with loans, or pay your tuition in full before classes start. Once you're accepted to SEU, you'll need to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) in order to qualify for any type of financial aid. Be sure to check with your site director about any scholarships available at your site.
